

Kingdom Come Part 1 | July 15, 2018

MAIN POINT:

When the will of God's heart is done
That is when His Kingdom comes

ICEBREAKER: What is one thing you are absolutely sure is God's will for your life? How are you so certain?

EXPLORATION:

1. Read Acts 6:7. In what ways have you seen the word of God spread? What is the best way for you to spread God's word (Through action, speech, etc.)? In What areas of you life do you struggle to exemplify God's word?
2. Read Acts 12:5. How has prayer impacted your life? How have you seen prayer impact the lives of those around you? Discuss the importance of praying for the Church around you. How can you make an impact by praying for the ones who need it most?
3. Read Acts 16:30-34. What is the importance of everyone sharing the gospel? In your life, are you actively seeking opportunities to share the gospel to see souls saved? In what ways can you impact the Kingdom in this way? Who could be your Philippian jailor?

APPLICATION:

1. Read Acts 19:20. Define prevail. Look back over your life and think of something that has truly prevailed. Think of the positive emotions that came from that event. Think about how beneficial the Word of God has been to you and ways that you can show that to others to let God's Word spread. Share both of those areas with the group.
2. Read Proverbs 2:42. In the Bible, prayer is mentioned over 300 hundred times. A hermeneutical principle states that repetition is a sign of importance. Over the course of the next couple of weeks, ask yourself where your prayer life can improve. Maybe you need to start a prayer journal or prayer wall to help with the discipline of prayer. Share your ideas with the group.
3. Have a time of prayer and application. Before praying, reflect over the past couple of months and see where you are not showing God's word through your actions as well as where you need to improve your prayer life. Pray for the people around you and that His Kingdom will surely come.
