

One Thing Part 2 | One Response | February 11, 2018

MAIN POINT:

**Our Response in Worship Should
Reflect the One We Worship**

ICEBREAKER: If you could meet and have coffee with any famous person, who would it be? Why? What would your response be to meeting them?

EXPLORATION:

1. Read Psalm 90:2. Reflect on the study of God's attributes from last week. He is Eternal, Holy, Immutable, Infinite, Omniscient, Omnipresent, Omnipotent, Sovereign, Triune, Relational, and Love. In light of the Westminster Shorter Catechism below and these characteristics of God what do you think our worship of the Lord should look like?

Westminster Shorter Catechism: What is the chief end of man?

"The chief end of man is to glorify God, and enjoy Him forever."

2. Read Psalm 33:1-3, Psalm 71:23, Isaiah 12:6, and Ephesians 5:19. All of these verses indicate that we should raise our voice and shout to the Lord. How do you think this should be applied in corporate and private worship?
3. Read Psalm 47:1 and Psalm 98:8. Both of these verses reference clapping hands in worship. Is this something you feel comfortable doing or could feel comfortable doing?
4. Read Psalm 63: 1-4 and Psalm 134:2. These verses emphasize raising your hands in worship. Is this something you feel comfortable doing or could feel comfortable doing? Discuss all of the different things this could express. (*Context Clues- raising your hands can represent desire, surrender, trust, receiving, giving, and many other things. The hands should mirror what the heart is expressing*)
5. Read Psalm 149:1 and Psalm 150:4. Both of these verses describe dancing before the Lord in worship. Is this something you feel comfortable doing or could feel comfortable doing?
6. Read Psalm 5:7 and Psalm 95:6. Both of these verses describe bowing before the Lord. Is this something you feel comfortable doing or could feel comfortable doing?

APPLICATION:

1. How do these responses reinforce the Main Point of this study: Our response in worship should reflect the One we worship.
2. Read Revelation 5:8-13. Identify the responses to worship in this passage. What do you think it will be like to be in that environment?
3. Possibly pick a worship song to play and worship God's greatness.
4. Have a time of prayer. In this prayer time make sure to take the time to worship and praise the Lord for He is worthy!!
