ICEBREAKER: If you were a super hero, who would you want to be? Why??

MAIN POINT:

Live For Who You Were Made By

EXPLORATION:

1. Read Proverbs 14:26. What does it mean to fear the Lord? Ask yourself if you truly fear the Lord, and if you don't, what needs to change? In what ways do you need to take refuge in the Lord?
2. Read Proverbs 3:5-6. What does this verse mean to you? Are there areas of your life where you are not giving all of yourself to the Lord? Where is it hardest to trust the Lord with all of your heart?

APPLICATION:

1. Read Proverbs 20:7. Define integrity. If this is something you struggle with, think about ways where you are falling short. Ask yourself if are begin a good example to the ones that are around you? In what ways can you improve?
2. Read Proverbs 31:8-9. What do these two verses mean to you? Are you willing to stand up for what is right? How can you begin to be a voice for the people who cannot help themselves? When is a good time to intervene when someone is dealing with a difficult situation?
3. Read Proverbs 4:7-11. What does it mean to rest in the Lord? In what ways do you need to love more? How can you show love to others throughout the week?
4. Have a time of prayer and application. Before praying, reflect over the past couple of months and see where you are not loving/standing up for what is right. Ask the Lord to guide you in standing up for others in a loving manner. Ask Him to allow this to become part of your everyday routine.
