

**ICEBREAKER:** What is one thing you are absolutely sure is God's will for your life?  
How are you so certain?

**MAIN POINT:**

**When the will of God's heart is done  
That is when His Kingdom comes**

**EXPLORATION:**

1. Read Acts 4:11-12. What does it truly mean to follow God? When is a time in your life that you have had to "let go and let God?" Has the Lord ever told you to "Go" but you didn't? How did you feel after? Discuss your thoughts with the group.
2. Read Acts 14:21-28. What is your personal idea of church? What does it look like, do you have to have a building? In what ways can you 'plant a Church?' In what ways, if any, is the Lord telling you to take part in planting churches?
3. Read Acts 5:12-16. What is something in your life that you feel is impossible? How are you dealing with it, are you making the Lord present in the problem?

**APPLICATION:**

1. Read Acts 4:33. In what areas in your life do you need to put Christ central? What ways can you make this possible? Discuss with the group ways that you can stretch yourself to allow God to become central.
2. Read Acts 19:8-10. How are you participating in planting churches? In what ways are you helping the Church (big C) to form? Discuss ways that you are helping the Church (big C) spread and helping plant churches.
3. Have a time of prayer and application. Before praying, reflect over the past couple of months and see where you are needing to put Christ Central. Ask the Lord to give you opportunities to begin to help plant churches and share the Gospel.
