AWANA's goal is to teach all kids, youth and their families throughout the world to know, love and serve the Lord Jesus Christ. AWANA is an acronym, Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed, taken from 2 Timothy 2:15 "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the Word of truth."

AWANA is a fun and engaging program that is so exciting that kids can't wait to come back for more!! But fun is only the start. While kids are having a blast, they're learning and growing too. They participate in games and activities that train their bodies. They learn verses and spiritual truths that expand their minds. They encounter life lessons that feed their souls from caring, trained leaders who invest their time, love and wisdom into shaping children's lives. Our Sunday School AWANA program includes Cubbies (2-4 years old), Sparks (K-2nd grade), T&T (3rd-5th grade) and Trek (6-8th grade).
