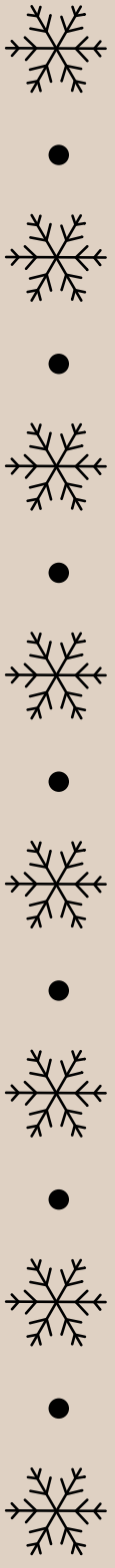

# A Message From Pastor Drew



Beginning January 4, we'll be starting a new sermon series called "What Is...?"—a simple title for an important set of questions.

The Christian faith is full of words we hear often: grace, faith, salvation, forgiveness, repentance, holiness, reconciliation. They're familiar, even comforting—but many of us have never had the chance to slow down and ask what they actually mean, where they come from, and how they shape real life.

This series is an invitation to do just that. Each week, we'll take one of these core Christian terms and explore it carefully—not as a test of knowledge, but as a way of deepening understanding. We'll look at how Scripture uses these words, how they've been understood over time, and why they still matter for everyday faith.

Whether you've been part of the church for decades or are still finding your way, "What Is...?" is designed to be welcoming, honest, and practical. No jargon required—just curiosity and openness.

We hope you'll join us as we slow down, ask good questions, and listen for the good news woven through the language of our faith.
