# Appleton Christian Church Annual Meeting January 28, 2024 Minister's Report

This last year has been an incredible year for the Body of Christ here at Appleton Christian Church.

We began the year averaging 129 people each Sunday in January and ended the year averaging 160 people attending in December. Our lowest attended Sunday saw 107 gather together on a snowy first day of the year, and our highest attended Sunday had 180 thanking God together the Sunday before Thanksgiving week.

Our mission is not about numbers attending Sunday services... it is to "Glorify God as we grow fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ." The numbers are important though. More people gathering in fellowship together hopefully more people growing in Christ.

This last year we had 4 baptisms, and 14 people joined the church.

One of my favorite numbers though shows how amazing you are at showing the difference between the world and the body of Christ... His church. Of the 38 visitor cards we received (not every visitor fills them out), 20 have continued to attend... either regularly or occasionally.

There have been so many people involved in ministry this year. Appleton Christian has been busy. You have really been creative in helping and loving each other (letters, calls, dinners, and visits)... and that is ministry. You have prayed for each other and our ministries. You have given foster children in our valley an amazing Christmas through participating in the Project 1:27 Polar Express event.

You greatly blessed our Christmas family of seven... and you have shared the love of Jesus and sent gifts to 279 children throughout the world through the Christmas boxes.

You have cooked for each other, participated in ministry through various opportunities on Sunday morning, and you have encouraged your pastors and staff (and yes, that is ministry too).

In all, when we counted it up (and we may have missed some), 150 members/attendees of Appleton Christian Church have actively participated in some ministry this year. That is roughly 86% of those who have attended regularly this year (175). That is the highest number of participation since I came to Appleton Christian, and that is why we are growing together.

Paul writes in **Ephesians 4:11-13** what is expected from Alan and I (elders as well). Paul wrote, "It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, 12 to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up 13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ."

This year, more than any other year in my ministry, I have seen this scripture fulfilled. As you have been doing the works of service (ministry), the church has grown both spiritually (becoming mature) and closer in fellowship (unity in the faith). And together we are beginning to attain to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ... What Jesus truly wants for and from His Church. This is such an exciting time.

I am so very blessed to be part of this family of God... and I pray that all of us become excited to share His love with others so that His church at Appleton Christian can reach the loss and grow His body.



I recently watched a short documentary on someone who used artificial intelligence (AI) to compose a worship song that would sound like a contemporary Christian song. Now I am not going to spend our time talking about the dangers of AI or critiquing Contemporary Christian Music. Instead, I was struck by how something that has no soul, no heart, no mind, no spirit can, at the push of a few buttons, imitate the worship of the saints.

I was struck by this for several reasons. First, it is amazing that we live in an age where that is even possible, secondly how easy it

was for the computer to do it, third how even though it fooled people into thinking a person had written it, there seemed to be something about it that all who heard it were uneasy about, and finally, how I spent some of my life acting just like AI.

Let me explain. I grew up in church. Now, I love and adore the church, the traditions, the rituals, all of it. But there was a time when I was doing nothing more than imitating the authentic without really understanding or experiencing what this faith is all about. I could answer the questions correctly (it was always Jesus), I could sing the songs, and even act like a good Christian kid. Looking back, it is obvious that I was doing it with no real intelligence, no real soul, no real connection.

I had learned that if you give me the proper input, I could fake the output, not only that, but I could fool most people while doing it. Then I spent time around some Christian's that seemed to know that something wasn't right. I was on a mission's trip, and without going into detail, they seemed to be able to look right through my artificial spirituality and even more importantly were willing to challenge me. They confronted the façade and made me listen to them proclaim the gospel as I had never heard it before. I began to realize that I may be able to fool a lot of people, I may be able to gain my earthly satisfaction, but it was costing me my eternal soul. I still rejoice in those hard conversations and moments of repentance. My faith came alive as those precious saints stooped down and spiritually washed the feet of a wretch like me.

After many years in ministry, I have discovered that my experience of artificial spirituality is not uncommon. There are many who simply go through the motions, they have the right answers and do the right things, but in their honest moments they know that they do not feel close to the Lord. They're not sure why people believe that their faith is strong, they are just faking their way through it.

If that is you today, then let me encourage you. The one you are looking for is not hard to find. The pressure of performance is something that you can drop right now. Your Savior has already done all the work needed for you to experience the fullness that he has to offer. Just drop the artificial, take a bold step and admit that you are faking it, repent, confess, and cry out to the Jesus and he WILL answer.

# *Jeremiah* 6:16 says, "Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it and find rest for your souls."

Over the next several months, the Discipleship Institute will be offering several one-day trainings, where we will learn to walk together on the ancient paths. If you are ready to experience your faith more fully, then let me encourage you to join as many of these as you can.

# New Ministry at ACC - Clothed In His Love

Donna Jean Ganss, Elizabeth Kovarovics and Connie Fudge are organizing to make simple clothes to add to our annual Samaritan's Purse Christmas Shoeboxes. The idea is to make simple dresses, skirts and pants ahead of time so that we will have plenty to put into the shoeboxes. These items of clothing will be for children ages 2 to 14 years. We seek your prayers as we begin this new adventure. We are hoping to possibly expand it beyond the Shoeboxes, eventually.

# Many hands, talents and levels of interest are needed:

# **HANDS-ON:**

We are calling for people who know how to sew AND people who would like to participate in some way, but do not sew. Sewers are asked to bring their sewing machines and basic sewing needs: scissors, machine needles, pins, etc. If you don't have a portable machine, we can work with that. Just let us know. Those who do not sew can do many other things for this project – cut out materials, hand sew, iron, etc.

On Saturday, February 17th, from 9 to 12, we will be holding 2 workshops in the big building. One will be for teaching sewers how to make a simple dress. The other will be for instructing those who do not sew, how to cut out the materials for the items of clothing.

**Sewing Workshop:** If you are bringing a machine, please arrive 15 minutes before 9 so that you can be all set up and ready to go by 9. We will have ironing boards and irons on site, so you don't have to bring those.

**Cutting Workshop:** If you own a good pair of scissors for cutting fabric, please bring them with you, especially if you are left-handed! We will have some available if you don't own a good pair. We will be instructing on how to lay out the pattern pieces, pin, and cut the materials. We will also be teaching how to use a rotary cutter for those who are feeling confident in their ability to use these very sharp tools.
