# THE APPLE PRESS

## **Deuteronomy 7:9**

**Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations.**

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This passage from Deuteronomy is dear to me for many reasons. It was written to the Israelites as they were preparing to enter the promised land after their forty years in the wilderness. Those forty years of walking and waiting came about because those who had experienced God's miraculous deliverance from slavery in Egypt lacked the faith in God to overcome the giants in the land He had promised to give them. So, for those forty years God in His faithfulness had provided for and protected Israel until that generation had passed away, and now their children were going to inherit the promise of God.

### **I. The Lord your God is God!**

This passage was reminding those children (and us) that "the Lord your God is God." God had shown His power delivering Israel from Egypt and by overcoming every challenge and circumstance in the wilderness and now Israel (and us) needed to remember and rely on that fact... God is God!

How often do I just run through my life, getting the next urgent thing done and striving to do it all in my own power. I too need to be reminded of the power of our God... and let Him be God in my life. The Lord our God is God.

### **II. The Faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love.**

Reminding the Israelites about the faithfulness of God might seem unneeded. They had seen so many miraculous signs of God's faithfulness. Every day they exited their tents to go pick up mana and quail. And yet, God still reminds them that He keeps His covenants and continues to love His people with a steadfast love. God had promised them a new land and the help to clear out the current inhabitants, and with that challenge still ahead of them it was good to be reminded that God is faithful and keeps His promises.

I have seen so many instances where God has delivered me and those around me from very difficult situations. Jesus promised that He would never leave us or forsake us... and He hasn't. Yet, there are new challenges, and new obstacles that we face, and being reminded that our God is faithful and keeps His promises to us because He loves us is so very important. As Jeramiah wrote in **Lamentations 3:22-23**, "**The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.**"

### **III. The Faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments.**

Israel had traveled through the wilderness because they had not loved God and kept His commands. They did not have faith that God could deliver the promised land to them. Now as their children are about to enter lands that contain peoples who would lead them away from obedience to God, they are reminded that their obedience to God's commandments is expected and rewarded.

We often lose sight of that truth ourselves. The world has so many ways for us to compromise our obedience to God that we can even find ourselves justifying our disobedience as just choosing the lesser of two evils. We need to remember there is no lesser of evils... there are just evils, and this world will tempt us in that direction. The Apostle Peter directed us in **1 Peter 1:15-16**, **“But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: ‘Be holy, because I am holy.’”** Our obedience to God is expected and He has given us all we need to live lives set apart (holy) in this world for Him. As Paul tells us in **2 Corinthians 5:17**, **“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”**

This new year I want to grow in my love for our Savior Jesus, and to do that I will be focusing on knowing His Word and His will so that I can live my life as the new creation He has made me. If I want to show my Savior my love... well, as He tells us in **John 14:15**, **“If you love me, you will obey my commandments.”**

#### **IV. To a thousand generations.**

The generation receiving this scripture had personally experienced God’s love and guidance for forty years. God telling them that his love and promises can be theirs for a thousand generations (eternity) to those who love Him and obey His commands is a beautiful gift to them. They had seen their parents die along the wilderness because of their lack of faith, yet they had still traveled in the love and protection of God.

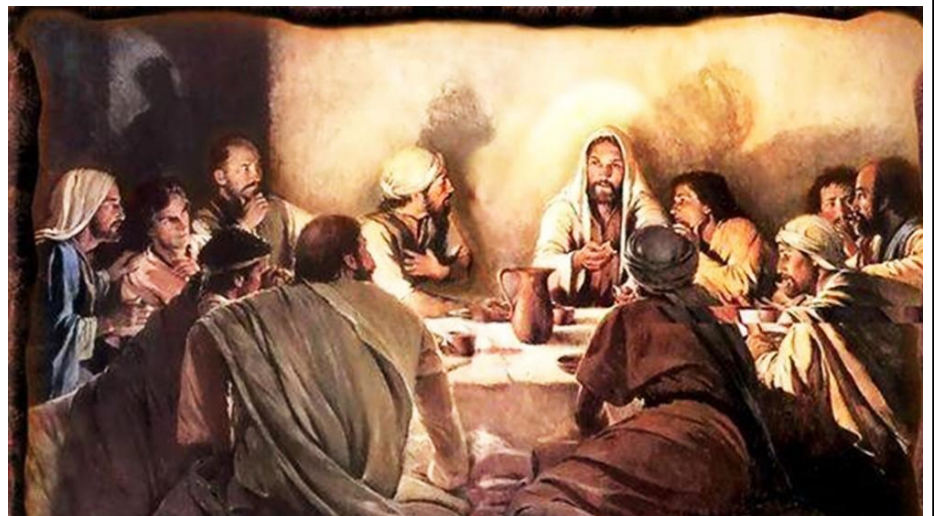
One of the most important aspects of our ministry here is to continue to be a place that teaches the truth of the Bible and grow the generations that God has given us into Christians that love Him and keep His commandments. If we do that, this valley will be blessed by our church family until our Lord comes back for us.

I encourage all of you to read God’s wonderful Word throughout this coming year, and that passages like this would bless you every day. I also ask that as you come across a passage that touches you, share that with Alan and me, or any of the other elders. We would love to hear what the Lord is saying and doing in your life.

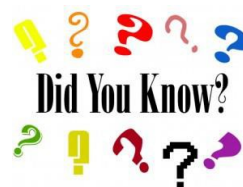

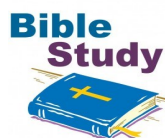

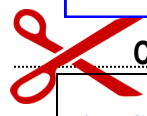
