As we near this goal we are looking at tackling these projects on next year's budget: a storm shelter for the parsonage, a shed at the back of the parsonage property for storage and lawn equipment, and also addressing drainage in between the church buildings.

In October the elders and deacons will meet to work on the 2026 proposed budget. Please communicate to the elders anything you would like for us to consider by the end of September.

Deacons

At the worship gathering prior our members meeting, we will request nominations for deacons. There will be blue cards by the offering box. Please write your nominations on the sheet and place them in the box. Please make your nominations prayerfully, meditating on 1 Timothy 3:8–13. If you have not yet listened to the sermon on that text from July 6th, we would encourage you to so.

After reviewing the nominations, the elders will prayerfully review them and begin contacting those nominated and doing interviews. Any elder recommendations will be published in the next letter along with completed deacon questionaries. In December we will present our recommendations for discussion. After we have done so, we will continue to welcome any feedback and will continue testing these men as you do so. If all goes as planned, we will present the recommended deacons at our March 2026 members meeting to be installed.

We've had to make some changes in the adult core course schedule for the fall. The elders are currently discussing what courses to provide next.
