Course Description

This course is a study of systematic theology. Systematic theology “seeks to apply Scripture by asking what the *whole* Bible teaches about any given subject.”¹ In Systematic Theology 2 we will continue our study of the doctrine of God and complete a study of the doctrine of man. While having taken Systematic Theology I would be helpful in orienting one for this course, it is not a required prerequisite.

Course Objectives

It is the aim of this course that God be glorified in the student by:

1. Their having a solid understanding of the various doctrines of the Word of God.
2. Their learning to read the Bible through the grid of a Scriptural systematic theology.
3. Their developing a theological mind to serve them in all of life.
