Dear Parents,

Christian greetings!

Thank you for giving prayerful consideration to enrolling your child as a student in Christian Bible Church Academy. We feel that it is both a ministry and privilege to provide Christian education for Christian children and teenagers. The staff of the school is dedicated to the task of helping your child fulfill his/her maximum potential in spiritual and academic matters.

The school is designed to be a life training extension of Christian parents who are solidly committed to the Lordship of Jesus Christ and have centered their lives upon His Word and the local church. We are committed to sheltering students from negative, humanistic influences of the world which will diminish their potential for God. As such, there should be a similar commitment on the part of parents to guard their children in the home and elsewhere from humanistic and ungodly influences.

The ultimate success of any student in a Christian school is very much contingent on the working relationship that is established between the school and the home of the student. Teamwork and unity based on Biblical truths and principles are of utmost importance.

Psalm 133:1 “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!”

Philippians 2:2 “Fulfil my joy, that you be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.”

Romans 15:5,6 “Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be like minded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

Thus, it is of great importance for you to be well informed as to the Biblical beliefs, characteristics, goals, values and requirements of the school. Hopefully, the following several paragraphs will fulfill that objective.

We are an Educational Ministry of Discipleship to the Lord Jesus Christ which has been serving Christian families in the greater Nashua area since 1983. Our graduates have been academically equipped and prepared to serve in the medical field (as doctors and nurses), in the ministry (as pastors and pastors wives), in the military (as an Air Force Academy graduate), high tech, education, and other trades and professions. However our ultimate focus is that as a disciple of The Lord Jesus Christ they will be a witness and testimony for Him in whatever future occupation, trade or profession in which they may serve.

With this in mind, we require all students to be genuine “Born Again Christians” who have a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. There is a Code of Christian Conduct which each student must commit to abide by while a student at Christian Bible Church Academy.

A major objective of the school is to serve Christian families in order to help them train their children to be lifelong followers of The Lord Jesus Christ (Proverbs 22:6 “Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.”) When there is consistent Christian training and emphasis in the home, church and school, it greatly increases the outcome of producing young men and women who will live for and honor The Lord Jesus Christ throughout their life. As such, the school is not only enrolling the student into the school, but also the values and priorities of their parents as well.

Thus, to ensure that we are able to work together for the training of Christian young people we require that:

1. Parents are also “Born Again Christians” who are serving the Lord.
2. If the student is living at home with both parents, both parents must be legally married. We are also honored to serve single parent families.
3. We require that both parents are regularly attending an Evangelical Church.
4. We require a letter of recommendation from the Pastor of the Evangelical Church in which they are congregants.
5. We require that the parents are in agreement with the basic biblical doctrines of an Evangelical Church. (Please see Doctrinal Agreement Form) These requirements are not meant to be critical of Christians or other churches that have different beliefs and priorities. Rather, these requirements are meant to inform you as to who we are as a school and whether we can form a wonderful working relationship as teammates to both spiritually and academically prepare your child to fulfil the great plan and blue print which the Lord has for their life.
6. Both parents will be required to attend an Award Ceremony which will be conducted at the end of each academic quarter on a Friday evening. The dates and time will be listed on the school calendar which you will receive.
7. After each of the first three academic quarters, you will also be required to attend a fifteen minute private meeting with your child’s teacher for an update on their spiritual and academic progress.

Subsequently, if you desire to enroll your child in Christian Bible Church Academy, the following procedure should take place.

1. Go to the church website (www.cbcnashua.com) and open the “Christian school” icon. **Please read all** the content of each of the subject tabs.
2. Download the application forms from the website or obtain an application packet from the church office. **Both** parents should fill out **all** application forms **in their entirety** and return them to the church office.

An appointment with the school principal will then be scheduled for you and your child. **Both** parents must attend, unless it is a single parent family.

Approximately one week after your appointment, you will receive a letter stating whether or not your child has been accepted. Acceptance will be based on whether we feel your child can adjust to our *spiritual* and *academic* program and whether we can properly meet his/her personal needs.

If your child is accepted, he/she will be required to take several days of diagnostic testing in order to determine his/her academic level. You will be sent the dates and the time of the testing.

Both parents will be required to participate in a parent orientation *at school* which takes approximately two hours. This orientation will give you detailed information concerning various aspects of our school program. We feel it is vital that each parent be familiar with the school procedures and terminology. No student will be permitted to attend school until **both** parents have completed this orientation.

Christian youth have a tremendous spiritual and academic potential. We believe that the program and environment provided at Christian Bible Church Academy is a tool in the hand of God to help your child fulfill his/her full potential. Should your child attend this school, the staff will work together with you in helping to prepare him/her to fulfill the will of God for his/her life.
