A Word of Salvation

Luke 23:46

*The Word of God records for us seven “words” that our Lord Jesus Christ spoke while on the cross. The second word was to the repentant thief on the cross, **Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise** (Luke 23:43). J.C. Ryle said these words “deserve to be printed in letters of gold” because they have been “the salvation of myriads of souls” who “will thank God to all eternity that the Bible contains this story of the penitent thief.” In the conversion of that one sinner, we find our comfort!
