PENTECOST SUNDAY

This Lord's Day we celebrate Pentecost—the day the risen and ascended Christ poured out His Spirit upon the Church.

In the days after the ascension, the disciples gathered together in faithful prayer, waiting upon the promises of God. Jesus had told them to remain in Jerusalem until they were clothed with power from on high. And so the Church waited—not in idleness, but in dependence, unity, and prayer.

Then, in Acts 2, the promise arrived in power.

This was the fulfillment of what God had spoken through the prophet Joel: "I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh." It was also the fulfillment of Christ's own words in John, where He promised that the Helper would come from the Father.

Pentecost is deeply connected to the ascension of Christ. The Spirit was poured out because Jesus had been exalted to the right hand of God. The enthroned King now sends His Spirit upon His people. What the prophets long anticipated had now begun.

At Pentecost, Jews from many nations heard the mighty works of God proclaimed in their own languages. The Gospel was going out to the nations, and the kingdom of Christ was beginning to spread throughout the world.

Pentecost reminds us that the Church is sustained not by worldly strength, but by the power of the Holy Spirit. The same Spirit who filled the apostles still convicts sinners, strengthens believers, comforts the saints, and builds the Church of Jesus Christ.

Christ reigns. The Spirit has been poured out. And the Gospel continues to go forth to the ends of the earth.
