Built Different – Part 3: Built for What?

1 Peter 2:1-10

1. We are Built for Worship.

The sermon reminded us that God instructed His people to build altars with **uncut stones**—raw, imperfect stones. How does that picture challenge the idea that we have to "get our lives together" before we can truly worship God? What does authentic worship look like in your current season?

2. We are Built for Community.

Peter describes believers as **living stones** being built together into God's spiritual house. Why do you think it is so easy for people to try to follow Jesus in isolation? How has biblical community strengthened you during a difficult season?

3. We are Built for Him.

According to 1 Peter 2:10 and Ephesians 2:10, our identity is no longer found in what we've done or what others say about us—it is found in Christ. What voices or labels have you struggled to believe about yourself, and how does God's truth replace them?

4. We are Built with Purpose.

The message ended by reminding us that each of us can reach people that others cannot. Who has God uniquely placed in your life that may need an invitation to church or a conversation about Jesus? What might be keeping you from taking that step?

This Week's Challenge

1. Worship Before the Breakthrough

Spend at least **10 uninterrupted minutes each day** worshiping God—not because everything is going well, but simply because He is worthy. Choose worship over waiting for life to be perfect.

2. Strengthen Your Community

Take one intentional step toward biblical community this week. Encourage someone, invite someone to coffee, attend your group, or reconnect with someone you've drifted away from.

3. Live on Purpose

Prayerfully identify **one person** God has placed in your life who needs hope. Pray for them every day this week, then intentionally invite them to church or begin a spiritual conversation before next Sunday.

I think these questions flow well with the sermon while moving beyond simple recall and encouraging personal reflection and practical application—the same style you've been using for the **Built Different** series.
