“I Need The Holy Spirit To Help Me!”



“And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever.” – John 14:16 (NKJV)

SAY:

When Jesus left the disciples and went to Heaven, the disciples thought they didn't have what it took to follow the plan Jesus gave them to “go into all the world and make disciples of all nations.” They were right.

None of us have what it takes to do the Great Commission on our own. That's why Jesus sent a “Helper,” the Holy Spirit, to be the one to help us with His goals!

READ:

John 14; Acts 1-2

DISCUSS:

- What did Jesus promise to send to the disciples?
- Where did Jesus go after He promised to send the Holy Spirit?
- What were the disciples doing while waiting in Jerusalem?
- Were the disciples weak after they received the gift of the Holy Spirit?
- Does the Holy Spirit truly help us live for God?

SAY:

The Holy Spirit is “Our Helper” sent by God to help us with guidance, helps us have comfort and peace, and helps us know when we have sinned.

PRAY:

Lead your children in a time of seeking the Holy Spirit. Have them ask the Holy Spirit to come into their lives and help them with guidance, comfort, and knowing when they have sinned.
