

Built to Represent (Part 4)- Going Deeper Questions

Question #1: If someone only observed your life this past week, what would they conclude about Jesus? Where do your actions most clearly reflect Jesus? Where do they most clearly fall short? What would it look like for you to become more intentional about representing Jesus in your “ordinary” daily moments?

Question #2: Where in your life do you feel pressure to blend in with culture rather than stand firm in Christ? Are there moments where you adjust your behavior, language, or convictions depending on who you’re around? What would it look like for you to embrace your identity as someone who does not fully belong to this world? Where is God calling you to live differently instead of comfortably?

Question #3: How do you typically respond when you are under authority you don’t like or agree with? What does your attitude look like toward leadership at work, school, church, or home? Are there areas where frustration or resistance has replaced honor and respect? Is your character strengthening or weakening your witness?

Question #4: When you are mistreated or misunderstood, what is your natural response? Where do you struggle most with releasing control and trusting God’s justice? What would it look like for you to respond more like Jesus in your next moment of tension? Are you willing to trust God with what you feel you need to defend?

Question #5: Are you aware of your influence at home, work, school, or online? How intentional are you about pointing people toward Christ through your life? What is one relationship where God may be calling you to represent Him more clearly? What kind of picture of Jesus are others receiving through you?

Question #6: When was the last time you intentionally shared your faith or pointed someone toward Jesus? What holds you back from sharing the gospel more openly? How can your life become more intentional about leading people toward Christ this week? What would it look like for you to move from silent belief to active representation? Who in your life needs to hear the good news from you?

Challenge:

1. Identify one area where your actions need to better reflect Christ.
2. Pray for one specific person who does not know Jesus, and intentionally look for an opportunity to point them toward Him.
3. Reflect daily on this question: “What picture of Jesus did I show today?”
