

Strategy to Keep Building! (Part 7) - **Going Deeper Questions**

Question #1: Where in your life have you started something God called you to but haven't finished? What stopped you? When distractions come, what tends to pull you away the fastest people, pressure, fear, or comfort? Have you been treating distractions like opportunities instead of recognizing them as assignments from the enemy?

Question #2: When pressure rises, do you run to God or do you react emotionally first? Why do you feel that this is the case? What step can you take to run closer to God rather than embracing the pressure. What voices have you been listening to lately—and are they grounded in truth or driven by fear?

Question #3: How strong is your current prayer life when compared to the level of opposition you're facing? What would it take for you to strengthen your prayer life? Are you more influenced by what people are saying about you or what God has said to you? Why is this the case? Are you spiritually grounded enough to recognize when something "sounds right" but isn't from God?

Question #4: In what ways could God be using your current opposition to strengthen your faith and endurance? What is one distraction you need to eliminate this week so you can stay focused on your assignment?

Question #5: Who in your life helps keep you grounded in truth and are you intentionally staying connected to them? If you committed to finishing strong, what would need to change in your daily habits? One year from now, what will your life look like if you *stay committed* versus if you *walk away now*?

Challenge:

1. This week, identify and eliminate one key distraction that is keeping you from your assignment
2. Take a moment this week to strengthen your spiritual foundation. This could include consistent prayer, time reading the bible, developing Godly community, etc.
3. Take one step toward finishing what God started in you.
