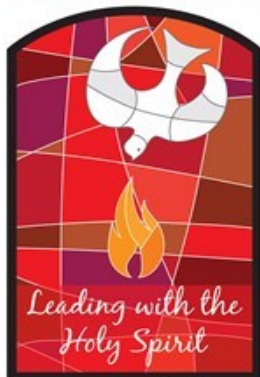

## KY Annual Conference Begins Monday, June 11

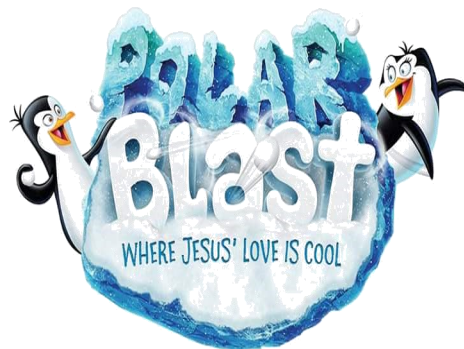
