Nursery Policies & Procedures

We encourage your help and cooperation in insuring the smooth running of the Nursery!

General Nursery Procedures

1. Make sure all items brought to the Nursery are labeled with your child's name (bottles, pacifiers etc.)
2. Pick up your child's name tag at the Sign In table, placing the larger part on the child's back and the smaller part on the diaper bag. Keep the small number portion for check out.
3. Hand your child over the door to the Nursery Worker.
4. When picking up your child from the Nursery, please return the number card to the Nursery worker.
5. PLEASE LET US KNOW OF ANY ALLERGIES.
6. If you are new to the church please fill out the registration form that is on the table outside the room.

Nursery Health Policies

In order to insure a safe and healthy environment for your children and the Nursery workers, please do not bring your child if he/she has had any of the following symptoms within the past 24 hours:

- Diarrhea, illness, food or medication induced
- Vomiting
- Fever (100 or above)
- Undiagnosed rash
- Open sores
- Runny nose (anything but Clear)
- Discharge in and around the eye(s)

Nursery Cleanliness

Every crib sheet, blanket and burp cloth is changed before and after each use. All toys are washed, disinfected and checked to make sure they are not broken. All tables, chairs, door-knobs and diaper changing areas are also disinfected to insure the utmost safety for our children and the prevention of the spread of germs and diseases. Our Church is dedicated to providing a safe place for our children.
