Morgan Hill Presbyterian Church (MHPC) is seeking a full-time Student Ministries Director / Minister who possesses a personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, a heartfelt desire to work with young people, and a proven record of building and growing a student ministry program that is attractive to junior and senior high students. The person we are looking for should be passionate, enthusiastic, creative, flexible, and dynamic with a mature and confident demeanor. The successful candidate will be relational to all ages and have very strong communication and social skills with both youth and parents. The candidate should have a good understanding of how to reach today's youth, the challenges on their personal time and the pressures of the young-adult culture, especially in the Silicon Valley.

MHPC is an evangelical Presbyterian congregation, and belongs to the Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians (ECO.) We believe the Bible to be God's Word and our only rule for faith and practice, we see salvation as coming through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, and we actively seek to help others come to know Christ. Because we uphold the Scripture's call to purity in our lifestyles, we believe that the staff members God calls to our church should abide by the ordination standards our church has set for our elders and pastors, which includes the call to practice "fidelity in the covenant of marriage between a man and a woman, or chastity in singleness." The person we are praying for should concur with these beliefs.

Morgan Hill sits at the southern tip of the San Francisco Bay Area in California. In 2016, we had a population of over 45,000 with nearly 14,000 households. Last year we were the second fastest growing city in Santa Clara County. Morgan Hill is popular for its proximity to Silicon Valley, yet still maintains a small town feel with strong family values. Our historic downtown offers restaurants and boutiques, public art displays, a year-round Farmer's Market and special events and festivals including a Fourth of July parade and Festival of Lights holiday parade! We are less than 20 miles south of San Jose however, it's not uncommon to see a tractor driving on a side road or someone riding horseback on a city street. The beautiful tree and grass-covered hills surrounding Morgan Hill contain pick-your-own farms, numerous award-winning wineries, lakes, golf courses, numerous hiking trails and vast open space. The year-round temperature is very temperate, with few freezing nights or scorching days.
