# PLANNING COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

September 19, 2023

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor Hardin is investigating online presence. The district offers seed money and demographic target marketing.

Properties Report: October's task list is ready for the next upcoming workday on Oct. 7<sup>th</sup>. Two green driveway entry lights need replacing. Waiting for a time to humanely spray bat repellent over the siding shingles. Doug Van Camp took an action item to provide solar lights and fans on the cargo container.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Jason Leube's treasurer work continues until October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Council discussed recommendations to fill the treasurer vacancy. At the previous August meeting, the July treasurer's report had been tabled pending three queries. Also, spoke about who will be a signer on our checking account.

Elders Report: More/new Elders and Ushers are needed. The use of nametags was discussed. Fundraising Committee: Flyers were made for the fall Harvest Festival and Craft Fair. Advertising was approved at \$250 for a full-page ad in the monthly Consumers Guide, which goes out to Woodland residents. There is a link on our

Preschool started August 21st, with a need for 1 teacher. Sunday School started Sept. 10th also with a need for teachers. Dale Chrisp took an action item to provide pest control access to the courtyard to spray for black widow spiders. An action item was also added for "pulling weeds in the school play yard" onto the church workday list. The group authorized \$1200 for the purchase of new playground equipment. Confirmation class has 2 students enrolled. Preschool is still waiting for grant money to arrive, possibly in October.

<u>Lay Ministry & Outreach:</u> In the month of October Manny Souza Is planning to collect

diapers for the Yolo County Diaper Bank. He is also looking into either Angel Tree or another organization to help underprivileged kids with gifts at Christmas time. There is an anonymous donor who will match up to \$3,000.

<u>Miscellaneous:</u> Pastor Hardin and Natalie Knabach investigating branding logos for our church.

<u>Audit Committee:</u> Laurette Farrier has volunteered to audit the church finances and procedures.

- Special Project Repair little light houses at the Cottonwood and Gipson driveways
- Monthly Use the Webster to clean spider webs off the exterior of the building
- Monthly Spray weeds in planters, parking lots and in shrubs
- Monthly Pick up trash in planters, parking lots and in shrubs
- Monthly Sweep up leaves and debris in front of the Church entry
- Monthly Dust choir loft, vacuum and empty garbage cans
