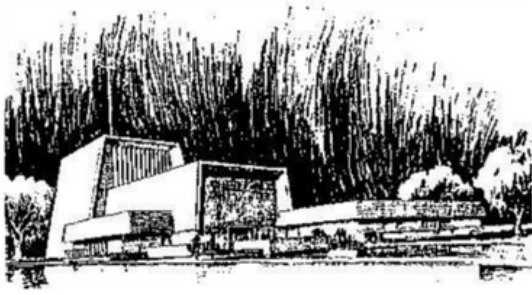

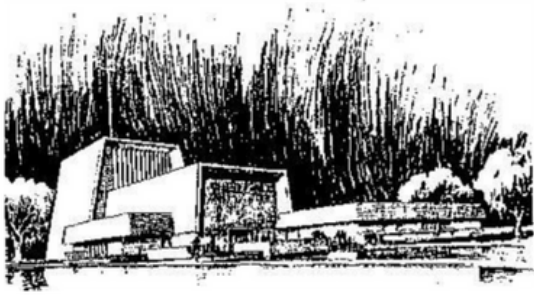

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Saints at St Paul's,

Lent is beginning February 18th with Ash Wednesday. This year we will follow a teaching theme of prayer and sections of Luther's Small Catechism with Bible texts. I want to ask you, do you think about prayer much? The Lord's prayer is not just something to memorize and repeat. It is an outline or tool of how we are to pray to our Lord. In prayer, be specific. What are you asking about or for? If God said yes to your prayer, or God said wait, would you know? Part of our Lent season we will look at our prayers and see how it connects to scripture and connects us to our Savior. Often we might pray that God would "bless our day." How would you know if God said, yes? Maybe he did and you missed it? What does scripture say about prayer and expectation? What blessings are we part of, but not seeing? How do we approach the Lord in prayer? How do we address concerns about our needs, struggles, relationships, hopes, and finding peace? Asking for help with a groan or sigh may not give us the insight we desire. 2 Cor 9:8 *And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.* God is able to do many things, do we see it, and are our ears or hands able to receive it? I pray this Lent season you are filled with eager expectation of the many blessings the Lord may show you!
