

NURSERY POLICIES

At Mandeville's First Baptist Church, your children's welfare is of the utmost importance to us. As a church we desire to create an environment where you feel safe and comfortable to bring your children. The following information will help you know what you can expect from our Children's Ministries.

All of our volunteers/paid workers that work with minors are required to have completed a background check with us.

Nursery:

- Bed babies—Pre-K meet in the Main Building.
- Childcare is available for weekly Sunday Morning, Sunday Evening, and Wednesday Night activities. Childcare may be available for other events but not guaranteed.
- Be assured that if your child cries in the nursery he/she will be redirected and soothed for 10-15 minutes and if the your child continues to cry, the parent will be contacted to pick-up the child.
- You may bring an extra change of clothes in case of an "accident." If none are available, parents will be notified immediately.
- If you inform the teachers that your child is being toilet trained, they will encourage your child, but no child will be forced to toilet train.
- Pre-K children will never be left unattended in restrooms.



KINDERGARTEN THRU 6TH GRADE POLICIES

At Mandeville's First Baptist Church, your children's welfare is of the utmost importance to us. As a church we desire to create an environment where you feel safe and comfortable to bring your children. The following information will help you know what you can expect from our Children's Ministries.

All of our volunteers/paid workers that work with minors are required to have completed a background check with us.

Children:

- Kindergarten—6th Grade usually meet on the 1st floor of the Discipleship Building.
- No child is ever to be left unattended in a room during children's ministry programming or classes.
- No form of physical discipline is acceptable, but a teacher may redirect or use time-out if necessary.
- A minimum of two children must go to the restroom together.
- All children must be picked up by a parent unless the parents inform the teacher of a designated person (16 years or older) that will pick-up the child.
- Life Group children in the 3rd grade and below must be picked up by a parent or designated person of 16 years or older.
