Jesus prays for _____ in John 17:6-19

"I ask on their behalf; I do not ask on behalf of the world but of those whom You have given to Me for they are Yours." -John 17:9

Jesus prays for _____ in John 17:20-26

"I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe Me through their word." -John 17:20

"I glorified you on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do."

#2— _____

"I am no more in the world, yet they themselves are in the world, and I come to You, Holy Father, keep them in Your name. . . I do not ask You to take them out fo the world, but to keep them from the evil one." -John 17:11, 15

#3— _____

"Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world." -John 17:17-18

#4— _____

". . . that they may be one; even as You, Father are in Me and I in You. . . that they may be one, just as We are one. I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity so that the world may know You sent Me." -John 17:21, 22, 23
