### ***Praise God for...***

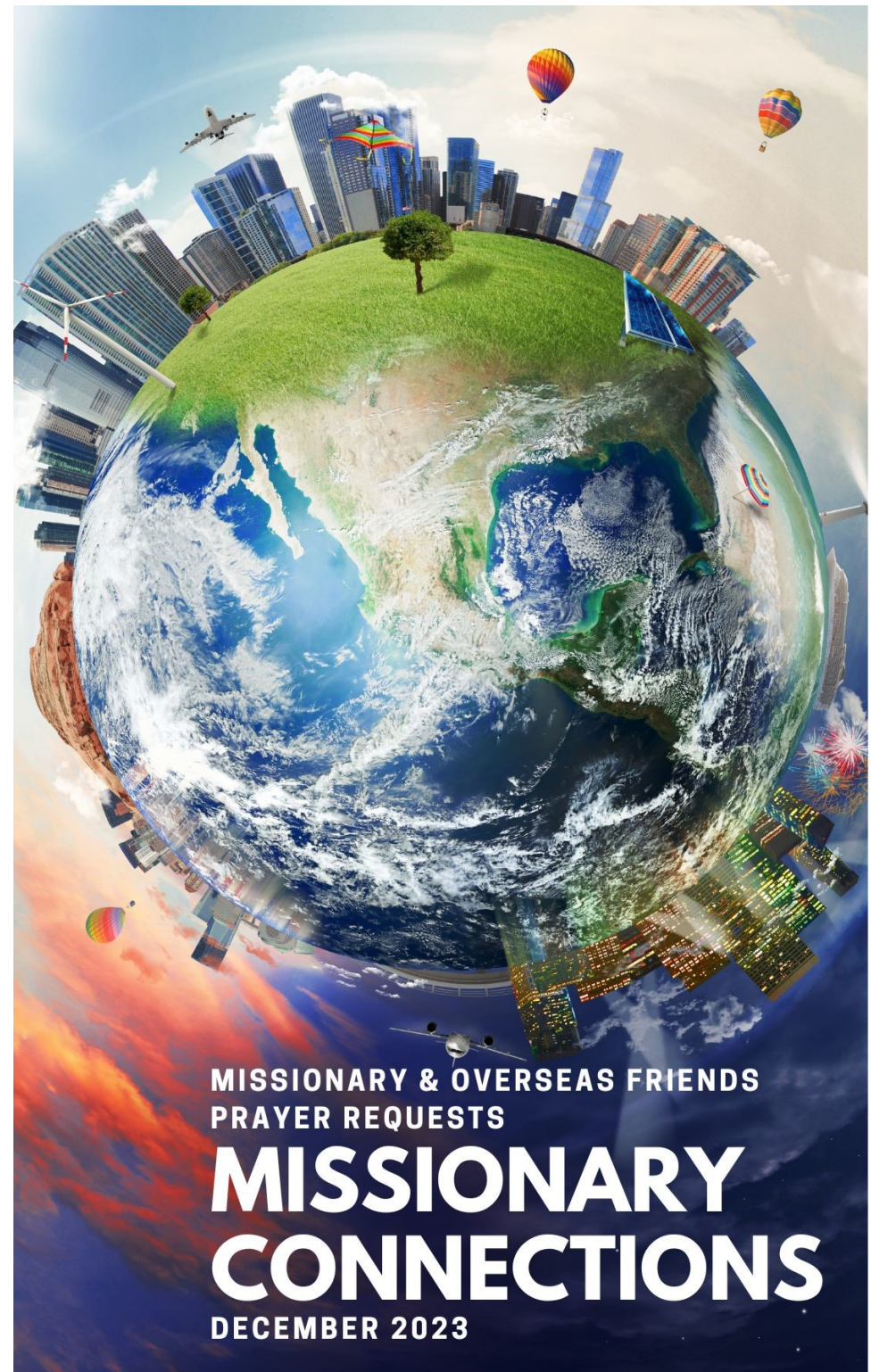
- ◆ A great year of clinics in Fiji and New Zealand and a fulfilling, fun & healthy time on their recent USA visit.
