


# Guidelines to Reopening

With the guidelines set by the Ohio Department of Health in mind, we are committed to providing a safe environment for Hillside's kids and disciple-makers (volunteers). These six guidelines will be utilized as we reopen our Kid's Ministry on Sunday, July 26.




**1. Health Screening:** Our disciple-makers and kids will complete a health screening including temperature checks with touchless thermometers prior to entering the facility and be free of fever (100 degrees or above), cough, runny nose, headache, and sore throat. We ask for your family to stay home and take advantage of online options if any member of your family is sick or has symptoms consistent with COVID-19.



**2. Masks:** Our disciple-makers will be required to wear a mask or face covering. Face coverings are recommended to be worn by kids, but not required. Never place face coverings on babies or children under 2, because of danger of suffocation.

**3. Healthy Hygiene:** We will have multiple hand-sanitizing stations and will encourage kids to use hand sanitizer when entering or exiting rooms. Our disciple-makers will wash hands upon arrival and use hand sanitizer often thereafter.



**4. Practice Social Distancing:** We will maintain proper social distancing through increased spacing. One person will man the check-in kiosks and print tags as families arrive. We recommend one parent per family to be in the kid's areas for check-in and pick-up. There will be tape lines to encourage social distancing and traffic flow. Our disciple-makers will limit physical touch whenever possible.

**5. Sanitation:** We will wipe down toys, tables, chairs, and other touched surfaces with disinfectant after each classroom session.



**6. Hand to Hand Items:** We will adjust activities and games to limit sharing of items. Kids will receive individual bags of supplies and will not share the supplies. The number of available toys will be minimized to assist with disinfection during and after classroom session.
