SUNDAY MORNING GROUPS



Our Sunday morning Connection Groups meet every week at 10:45AM, following our morning worship service. Groups exist for all ages, including children and youth. We value our groups as vital connection points to other Christians as we endeavor to learn, grow, and serve together..

COLLEGE/YOUNG ADULT GROUPS: Our College/Young Adult groups are open to college students, graduate students, and young adults.

NEW HOPE (Room 170): Our New Hope Group includes individuals in their 20's - 40's and typically follows a discussion format for learning.

NEW COVENANT (Room 163): Our New Covenant Group includes individuals in their 50's - 60's and typically follows a group discussion format for learning.

GENESIS (Room 126): Our Genesis Group includes individuals in their 50's - 70's and typically utilizes a lecture format for learning.

DOUBLE RING (Room 124): Our Double Ring Group includes individuals in their 70s - 80's and typically follows a blend of lecture based and group discussion style learning.

SANCTUARY QUESTION & RESPONSE (Sanctuary): Each Sunday, we host an open group in the sanctuary with the goal of providing space for questions, conversation, and deeper learning following the morning message.

SEASONAL TOPICAL STUDIES: Throughout the year, we also offer a variety of seasonal, topical studies. These groups typically last 6-8 weeks and focus on a specific topic, such as Financial Peace University.

WEEKDAY GROUPS

WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE STUDY (ROOM 126): Our Wednesday Night Bible Study meets each week from 6:30-7:30PM. The group is open to anyone and is a blend of lecture/group discussion style learning with the goal of deepening our understanding of how to read the Bible and to live out our faith as disciples of Jesus Christ.

LIFT WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY: LIFT meets each Saturday morning at 9:30AM at Maggie & Moe's Coffeeshop. This women's group is open to anyone who would like to attend and utilizes a group discussion style of learning.

SEASONAL WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY (Room 126): Our Seasonal Women's Bible Study typically meets once in the spring and once in the fall for approximately 8 weeks at a time. The study employs video/lecture style learning with some discussion.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES TO CONNECT

GOLF FELLOWSHIP GROUP

Our Golf Fellowship Group is open to anyone who wants to participate. The group currently meets on Mondays at 1:00PM at a local golf course. Follow our weekly newsletter for each week's location.

LUNCH FELLOWSHIP

Our Lunch Fellowship will begin in the fall of 2025 and will meet on the 3rd Thursday of each month. Lunch will be provided here at the church with a time for fellowship and connection.

MEET THE PASTOR LUNCHESES

Once a month, we host a lunch for those new to our church to meet our pastors and some of our Deacons. The meal is free, informal, and designed simply as a "get to know each other" event. We try to send out invitations to newcomers, but if you would like to be invited, and haven't been, please reach out and let us know!

MEN'S BREAKFAST

Our Men's Breakfast meets every Monday morning at 10:00AM at the Sunrise Cafe. All are welcome to attend.

PICKLEBALL OPEN GYM

We open our gym for Pickleball every Monday and Thursday evening from 6-8PM. Our goal is to provide a safe, welcoming place for first time players and seasoned pros to fellowship over the game. We operate 3 courts at a time and work to pair groups together based on skill level.

SEWING MINISTRY

Our Sewing Ministry meets on the second Saturday of each month at the church. The group fellowships while working on a variety of projects throughout the year.

FIRST LINK HOSPITALITY TEAM

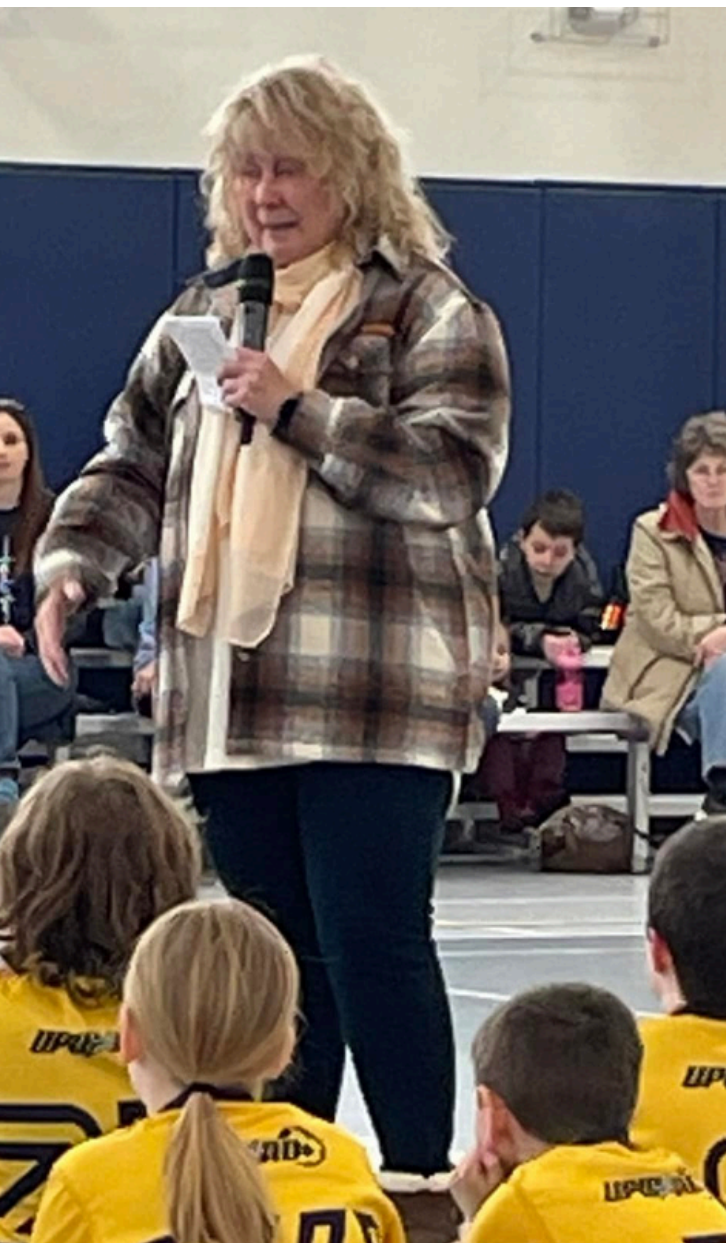
Our First Link volunteers work to create an inviting, hospitable environment for our members and guests before and after our morning worship services. This includes making coffee, providing snacks, and clean up.

KIDS HOPE MENTORS

MUSIC MINISTRY

Our Music Ministry offers a diverse, broad spectrum of opportunities to be involved. Whether you sing, play an instrument, act, design, paint, build, or would just like to learn, we love helping you find a place in our music ministry.

NURSERY & CHILDCARE

Each Sunday morning, our Nursery and Childcare volunteers provide a safe, loving place for parents to leave their babies and toddlers during worship and Connection Groups.

PICKLEBALL MINISTRY

Volunteers in our Pickleball Ministry help set up/tear down nets each week and serve as a friendly, welcoming face to greet guests and teach others how to play.

PRAYER TEAM

Our Prayer Team volunteers meet every Sunday morning at 9:00AM to pray prior to our service. Members also receive prayer requests throughout the week, as needed, as we keep our membership and those in need in prayer.

PRESCHOOL SUPPORT TEAM

Our Preschool Support Team serves to encourage, pray for, and support our First Friends Preschool teachers and aids. It's our own version of a PTO here at First Baptist.

SAMARITAN'S PURSE OCC VOLUNTEERS

Every year, we serve as a Drop-Off Location for Operation Christmas Child. Volunteers help to greet donors and carry, sort, and pack shoe boxes to be shipped to a processing center.



TECH & A/V TEAM

Our Tech and A/V Volunteers help us worship by running our sound system, in house media computer, and livestream computer/cameras each Sunday morning.

TRANSPORTATION TEAM

Our Transportation Team is currently inactive due to a lack of volunteers. When active, the team organizes transportation to and from our morning worship services using the church bus.

UPWARD SPORTS TEAM

Our Upward Sports volunteers do everything from greeting families on game days, to leading half-time devotions, working in concessions, or serving as a coach/assistant.

YOUTH MINISTRY TEAM

Our Youth Ministry Volunteers help teach on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights, provide leadership on trips, provide Wednesday Night Dinners for our youth, and more.
