DISTRIBUTION of CAMPERS and COUNSELORS in CAMP CAZADERO CABINS:

Several factors are taken into consideration when housing our campers and counselors. Age, sex, cabin capacities, the protective TWO ADULT Rule, accompanied and unaccompanied registrants, and friendship preferences are all factored in. As a result, camp cabins may be assigned to participants from more than one church or household, or it may require more than one cabin to house campers and counselors from a single church. The Redwood Empire Camp Directors will do their best to accommodate all campers and counselors according to their desired configurations. However, flexibility, courtesy, and cooperation must be exercised in the event your group is divided or recombined with members of another group.

When taking all these factors into consideration, **Camp Cazadero reserves the right to limit the number of campers and counselors** on campus at any time. If limits must be applied after registrations are received, those who register later may be precluded from participation and their registration fees will be returned in full.

Thank you for remembering that **meeting new people, learning teamwork, being flexible, and loving one's neighbor** are all lessons we learn from Christian camping.
