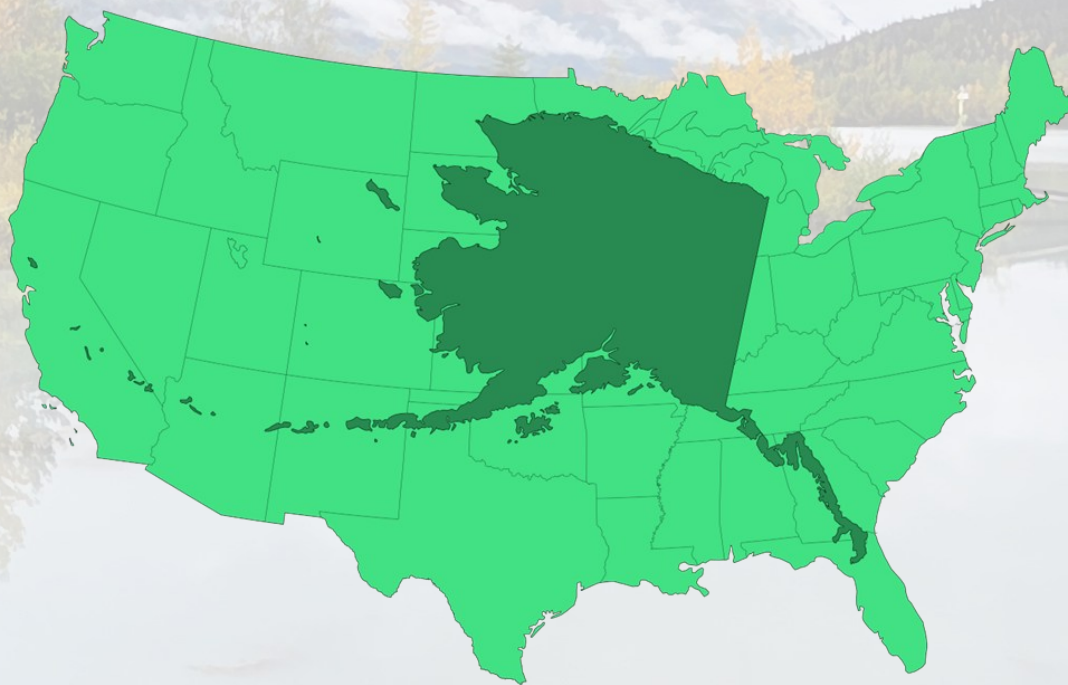

Why Alaska?

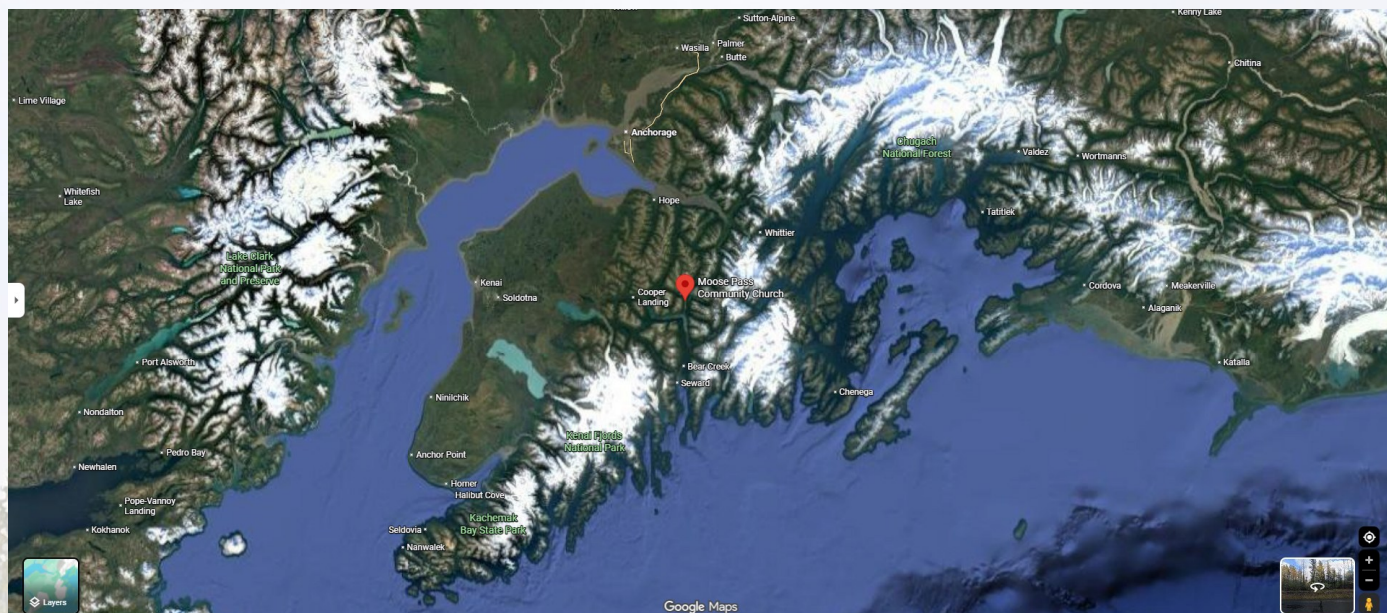
Alaska is approximately 1/5th the size of the contiguous states. Larger than Texas, California, and Montana combined. In 2024, the population was just over 740,000.

Did you know that Alaska is the least church-attending state in the US? Only 36% of Alaskans say they identify with any religious group. Alaska is far less churched than any of the Central American and Caribbean countries. People think of Alaska as a tourist destination, but it is a mission field.

In Alaska there are a total of 83 cooperating Southern Baptist churches and 25 missions.



Moose Pass



Located on what is known as the Kenai Peninsula, has a population of between 250-300 people. As you expand out a little further there is a population of about 500-700 people. Moose Pass Fellowship sits on the former location of the Moose Pass Community Church. There are only two churches, Moose Pass Fellowship and Moose Pass UMC.
