Enrollment and Tuition Facts

We provide care for children 6 weeks through 5th grade

- Non-Refundable Yearly Enrollment: \$100/child-Due July ever year
- Infants: \$135/ weekly fee
- Toddler-2 Years Old: \$130/week fee
- Three and Four Years Old: \$130/week (Includes 2K, 3K & 4K Preschool 9:00am-12:00pm)
- Afterschool Program: \$60/week (For school age children, 3:00pm-6:00pm)
- Supply Fee for 2K, 3K & 4K: \$25.00/year

Curriculum

Our center will be using "Zoo Phonics" and "Gospel Project" for our curriculum and as a guide for planning.

Security

We have a locked, secure building. We only allow access to authorized security card holders into the building through doors controlled by electronic key pads.

Registered

We are registered with the South Carolina Department of Social Services. we follow all regulations and guidelines and teacher ratios.

Snacks and Lunches

We provide two snacks and one lunch to our students from our kitchen each day. Menus are available.

Enrichment Activities

Chapel is provided every Wednesday by our church staff for the older two-year olds through four-year pre-school children. Group music time follows Chapel time. Computers are located in all of our older two's rooms through four-year old classrooms.

Recreation

We have a wonderful, secure playground area with shade. Summer activities include swimming at the local pool (3 year- fifth grades), visiting museums, parks and the zoo.
