Pastor,

But then you also said God loved men and sent His Son, Jesus Christ, into the world to redeem men from their sins and that all those who believe in him would go to heaven and live with God eternally.

My parents recently died in rapid succession. I know they did not believe in Jesus Christ, whom you call the Savior of the world. If what you preach is true, they are damned.

You compel me to believe that either the message is untrue, or that you yourself don't believe this message, or that you don't care. We live only three blocks from your church and no one ever told us. You hypocrites!

And then the young lady who sent it signed her name.

In Matthew 9, we read:

³⁷ Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. ³⁸ Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest."

Have you ever noticed the subtle but clear challenge of that prayer? Once you see it, you will never unsee it. Here it is: In praying for God to send somebody to the lost, the Lord is asking us to offer a prayer that we are clearly the answer to! In other words, the answer to the prayer is in the asking: It's you! It's me! We are the answer to the prayer! We are the "workers" who are to be sent "into His harvest."

Church, hear me: Go. Speak. Bear witness. The world is right next door, and the world needs Jesus.
