In Matthew 21:13, Jesus said that His Father's house is to be "a house of prayer." That is a definitional and foundational statement. Whatever else the church is, it must be a house of prayer and whatever else the church does, it must pray!

Toward that end, I wanted to inform you all of a prayer emphasis that we would like for our church to embrace prayerfully and with great hopes for revival! This emphasis is intended to be the beginning of what we trust will be a continuing and growing organic prayer movement in our church that will be encouraged by periodic corporate efforts like the one I am going to mention here.

This first effort has two parts:

1. A prayer emphasis weekend.
2. A 40-Day prayer challenge.

First, on Saturday, February 28, from 3–6 pm in the Fellowship Center, Dave McClung, pastor of Summit Church in Vilonia, Arkansas, will be with us. Dave is a dear brother in Christ who has led and is leading his church to embrace prayer. Dave's church is part of the Summit network of churches in Arkansas, the original church having been started by Bill Elliff, who works in concert with the SBC and other ministries to promote prayer and revival. Dave is going to offer two sessions on prayer that Saturday and we will also have dinner. Would you plan on attending this? Then, on Sunday morning, March 1, Dave will be preaching in our worship service.

Second, following the worship service on Sunday, March 1, 500 copies of Bill Elliff's book, *Prayer with "No Intermission: 40 Days to Unceasing Prayer,"* will be made available in the foyer of the

sanctuary for you to pick up. We would like to encourage our members to give \$5/book in the provided receptacles to help offset the cost, but we would like for you to take these copies for you and your family members regardless! (i.e., You taking the book is more important than you giving \$5!) There are 40 brief chapters in this wonderful book. We will be asking you to (a) commit to reading one chapter per day starting on Monday, March 2, and (b) watch one of the accompanying Bill Elliff teaching videos each week (a total of 6 videos, one-per-week for 6 weeks) to encourage you in your readings and journey of prayer. Some of our Sunday School classes are choosing to do this in their classes for 6 weeks (this is optional - classes do not have to do this). Some of you may choose to get small groups together to meet in your homes once a week for those 6 weeks, to watch the Bill Elliff videos, to discuss prayer, and to pray! Some of you may choose to do this as individuals! We will make the videos available to you all. Starting on Wednesday, March 3, I will also be showing these and teaching through this material on Wednesday nights for 6 weeks.

Would you join us in this effort? This is a simple, accessible, but meaningful way for us to gather as a church and to start thinking about and practicing prayer on a deeper level.

We believe that First Baptist Camden should be "a house of prayer."

I believe this is going to happen!
