When I was in college, I took a history class entitled "Napoleonic Warfare." I will never forget the professor: Dr. Owen Connelly. He was, when I had him, an elderly man with a somewhat grizzled demeanor. I actually mean that as a compliment! I liked him immensely. He was an aged military man and scholar who wore a bolo tie and had a gravelly voice and a dry sense of humor. It was fascinating to hear him hold forth about Napoleon, his specialty.

I'll also never forget the first day of class. He came in, went to the front of the class, looked briefly and wearily at all of us, then turned back to the board and wrote, in large letters, two words: "calvary" and "cavalry." He turned back to us and said: "Class, listen to me. That first word is 'calvary.' That is the hill upon which Jesus was crucified. That second word is 'cavalry.' That refers to a mounted soldier. I beg of you: Learn the difference between the two."

I still laugh to think about it. That poor gentleman had obviously suffered for years under student confusion on the point and had clearly determined that he never wanted to read another paper in which a student wrote "calvary" when he or she mean "cavalry."

One little letter can make a big difference in the meaning of a word!

Think of another example: the word "canon" vs. the word "cannon."

The latter word refers to an instrument of warfare designed to wreak havoc and bring maximum destruction. The former word—"canon"—refers to a standard.

Sadly, at certain periods in Christian history, the church has gotten behind cannons. That is not the calling of the church! Our church is seeking to gather around 4 Canons.

Our desire is to become an authentic family around the whole gospel for the glory of God and the reaching of the nations.

That is, we want to (1) love each other (authentic family) (2) with the love of Jesus (around the whole gospel) (3) so that beauty of God will be seen and celebrated (for the glory of God) (4) and so that the whole world will want to know King Jesus (and the reaching of the nations).

In my first sermon here, I invited you to lean on these canons. Test them. Hold them up to the light of scripture and ask yourself this question: Is this what Jesus wants us to be and to do?

If the answer to that is "yes," then let's do it and let's be it! By the power of the indwelling Spirit and in the name of the crucified and risen Son and for the glory of our great God, let us do it and be it!






