Attention all Ski Bunnies and Boys,

It's been 3 years, so it's time again to hit the slopes. We are heading back to the mountains this Spring Break for what I know will be another wonderful time of fellowship and fun and faith building. We will again be going in tandem with our friends from Wesley UMC, Greenville, with whom we do Camp Anakainoo. We will leave out on Saturday, March 7th and return Wednesday, March 11th. We will be driving, exact details to be determined depending on number of participants.

The trip is open to all youth . . . with one small catch! If your child is in the 9th – 12th grade, you may sign them up by themselves to participate in the trip. If your child is in the 6th – 8th grade, they may only attend if one of their parents goes as an adult sponsor on the trip. If both parents (or just one if in a single parent home) go on the trip, then they are welcome to bring any younger children if they want to make it a "family trip." Parents of 9th – 12th graders are more than welcome (and sponsors will be needed) as well.

The exact cost per person is still not definite as the mountain has yet to update all their pricing for the coming season, but this is a pretty close high-end estimate. But that being said, do NOT assume it will be much, if any, less than this. We estimated on the few items that have yet to be price set, but the majority of items were already priced.
