THE LAUNCH INITIATIVE

Arrowhead's Gap Year Program - The Launch Initiative (TLI) is an intensive discipleship and leadership training program designed to give graduated high school students real life experience prior to further education, finding a career, or starting a family. TLI is a "Bridge" that provides crucial mentoring, living skills training, personal development, and healthy community in the unique camping ministry context of Arrowhead Bible Camp. TLI uses a missions support platform, challenging students to develop a missional mindset, create a network of ministry supporters, and experience lifestyle ministry with the opportunity to complete the program debt free.

The Launch Initiative is a two semester experience. Students will live onsite at Arrowhead during for two semesters which correspond to the fall camp season, winter retreat season, and spring camp season. Each semester will include a combination of experience-based academics, spiritual formation & growth, professional training, and ministry experience.

LAUNCHING STUDENTS INTO COLLEGE, A CAREER OR FAMILY

Students will be engaged in a variety of classroom style instruction, offsite ministry trips, professional development, leadership training, mentoring, discipleship, serving as guest groups hosts & James Project Coordinators, and as staff for Shepherds Camp programming.

College Credit – 30 Hours

The Launch Initiative offers 15 credit hours each semester for a total of 30 credit hours. Students are required to apply to ACU to enroll in courses. Arrowhead Bible Camp partners with Eleven:6, a faith-infused experiential education organization, and Anchor Christian University, its distance learning delivery arm. Through an established agreement students will be able to transfer earned credit into Cedarville University, Clarks Summit University, Cairn University, and Lancaster Bible College at full transfer. ACU will be adding more schools to this list. Credit transfer to other schools is possible. Students are encouraged to contact their school of choice and ACU to determine

Schedule Overview

Fall Semester 2020 – September 9th to December 12th (14 weeks, including a 10 day break for Thanksgiving).
Winter Break – December 14th to January 3rd. Students will not be permitted to live at camp during winter break.
Spring Semester 2021 – January 4th to April 13th (14 weeks, including a 6 day spring break).

Program Cost

The Launch Initiative is designed for students to complete the program debt free. Students will raise financial missions support to cover the program cost, and build a network of ministry supporters. Room, board, and all activities are included in the Gap Year Cost. Students will begin raising financial support immediately after acceptance into program. Several missions support check points are in place to challenge students in their efforts. Arrowhead will provide support, coaching, and resources to aid students in their missions support goals.
