You should have received a welcome email from your child's camp teachers. In that email, you'll find important information about your child's classroom placement and a list of items to bring on the first day.

When you arrive at POP, please enter through our front office. All other gates will be locked. Our staff will walk you through the check in/out process if you are a new family. Classroom assignments will be posted on the board in the courtyard and staff will be present to help guide you and your child to your classroom. Please take time to meet your child's teachers.

Items to bring with you on the first day:

- A full change of clothes for your child in a bag labeled with their name
- Diapers and wipes for children that need them (Rm 1- Rm 4)
- A packed lunch (if your child stays for lunch)
- A water bottle labeled with your child's name
- Closed-toe shoes
- A lightweight sweatshirt or jacket to use in classroom
(the AC is nice and cool)
- Optional: a blanket or "lovie" if your child will nap at school

Please make sure you are signed up with Procure. This is our biggest means of communication, sign in and out and billing.
