

# V. STUDENT DRESS CODE

## Rationale

King's Valley Christian School believes that a professional school environment is critical to student success. To this end, King's Valley has adopted a uniform code for all students. For any such code to be effective it must be supported by parents as well as staff. Full cooperation with the uniform code is expected from students, parents, faculty, and staff.

## Goal

King's Valley wants all of its students to maintain a neat, modest, and professional appearance while in the classroom that is in keeping with the student code of conduct. We want all students and parents to be free from pressure to keep up with the latest fashion trends, hairstyles, and other fads. Students should not judge each other by what they wear. Students should not appear sloppy or disheveled while in class, but should be dressed for academic success.

## Uniform Supplier

King's Valley has selected French Toast Official School Wear as its uniform supplier. Not all items from French Toast are part of the uniform code. King's Valley will not accept items from other uniform suppliers if there is any visual difference between the item and the items described in the code. If students wear pieces that are not part of the uniform code, they will be forced to change. Parents may be billed for replacement items. Other items may or may not be acceptable within the dress code at the sole discretion of King's Valley Christian School. ## General Rules

The faculty and staff, along with the support of the parents, will enforce this dress code. All clothing pieces should be in good condition and worn in the correct size. Final decisions regarding the interpretation of the dress code guidelines reside with the school administration. We reserve the right to prohibit the wearing of any clothing, hairstyle, cosmetics, or jewelry which seems to be immodest, inappropriate, or distracting.

## Free Dress

It is not uncommon for students to earn or receive several free dress days during the course of the school year. While free dress days allow students to dress outside the uniform code, all free dress should exhibit propriety. Administrative discretion will be exercised on dress code issues that come up throughout the year. Likewise, students may not free dress in items that promote themes or groups that would not normally be acceptable at King's Valley.

## Addendums

Further changes to the dress code may occur during the school year as King's Valley introduces items that bear the King's Valley logo.

Dress code violations are to be handled in the following manner:

**K-3:** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> violations of a semester are entered into Renweb and an email is sent to the parent/guardian. A third and/or subsequent infractions will result in the student being sent to the office.

**4-8:** A first violation per quarter is entered into Renweb and an email is sent to the parent/guardian. Subsequent infractions are entered into Renweb and the student will receive detention.

## **Boys Uniform Code**

### **OUTERWEAR**

Sweatshirts may be navy blue or forest green only. They must be plain, and without designs, logos, or other colors. Jackets should be predominantly navy blue or forest green. Jackets may have piping or detailing in other colors, but they should not have any large logos or designs on them. Jackets should only be worn for warmth and students may be required to remove them in class. Sweatshirts and jackets bearing the KVCS logo are permitted. Hoods are not allowed to be worn indoors. No hats are allowed on campus. Plain navy blue beanies are allowed on cold days only. Gloves are allowed when necessary for warmth and must be brown, black, navy blue, or forest green. Gloves/beanies may not be worn indoors.

### **HAIR**

Hair must be neat and conservative in style. No unnatural hair coloring allowed.

### **MAKEUP/JEWELRY**

No earrings or other body piercing jewelry is allowed. No occult or new age jewelry. Bracelets and wristbands are not allowed unless they are produced by King's Valley. A single necklace may be worn, but should remain under the uniform shirt. Fingernails should not be painted or colored. No makeup is allowed.

### **SHIRTS**

White oxford shirt (long or short sleeve) and white, forest green, and navy blue pique polo shirts. Undershirts may be worn but they must be both plain and white. Shirts must be tucked in. PE clothes may not be worn beneath a student's regular uniform.

### **BELTS**

Plain, black, brown, khaki, or navy belts are required at all times.

### **PANTS/SHORTS**

Navy or Khaki pants or shorts only. Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer. Cargo-style pants or shorts (with pockets on the sides of the legs) are not allowed. Jeggings, navy, tan, skinny, ripped or five-pocket jeans are not acceptable attire.

### **SOCKS**

Socks must be solid white, black, navy blue, or forest green. Socks must be matching, unaltered, and visible at all times. No designs (stripes or logos, etc.) allowed.

### **SHOES**

No sandals, open-heel/toe shoes, or boots allowed. No shoes with wheels allowed. No slip-on shoes may be worn during PE. Shoelaces must be tied.

### **FREE DRESS GUIDELINES**

No sweat, track or pajama pants allowed on free dress days. No ripped jeans.

## Girls Uniform Code

### OUTERWEAR

Sweatshirts may be navy blue or forest green only. They must be plain, and without designs, logos, or other colors. Jackets should be predominantly navy blue or forest green. Jackets may have piping or detailing in other colors, but they should not have any large logos or designs on them. Jackets should only be worn for warmth and students may be required to remove them in class. Sweatshirts and jackets sold by KVCS with the KVCS logo are permitted. Hoods are not allowed to be worn indoors. No hats are allowed on campus. Plain navy blue beanies are allowed on cold days only. Gloves are allowed when necessary for warmth and must be brown, black, navy blue, or forest green. Gloves/beanies may not be worn indoors. *French Toast Official School Wear Item #: Lined Jacket 1321; Cardigan 1370; Cardigan 1371; Hooded Sweatshirt 1400; Windbreaker 1528; Sweater Vest 1029; V-neck Pullover 1028*

### HAIR

Hair must be neat and conservative in style. No unnatural hair coloring allowed.

### MAKEUP/JEWELRY

Earrings are allowed, but other body piercing jewelry is not allowed. No occult or new age jewelry. Bracelets and wristbands are not allowed unless they are produced by King's Valley. A single necklace may be worn, but should remain under the uniform shirt.

### SHIRTS

White Peter Pan or Pointy Collared shirt (long or short sleeve) and white, forest green, and navy blue pique polo shirts. Undershirts may be worn but they must be both plain and white. Shirts must be tucked in. ### BELTS

Plain, black, brown, khaki, or navy belts are required with pants & shorts at all times. *French Toast Official School Wear Item #: Belts 2417/2416*

### PANTS/SHORTS

Navy or Khaki pants or shorts only. Shorts may not exceed three inches above the knee (even on free dress days). Jeggings, skinny, ripped jeans or five-pocket jeans are not acceptable attire. Cargo-style pants or shorts (with pockets on the sides of the legs) are not allowed. *French Toast Official School Wear Item #: Pants 1273; Pants 1315; Bermuda Short 1303*

### SKIRTS, SKORTS & JUMPERS

Skirts and skorts must be Navy, Khaki, or French Toast Green Plaid. Jumpers (K-4 only) must be khaki or navy blue. The distance between the skirt and the top of the knee may not exceed three inches above the knee. *French Toast Official School Wear Item #: Navy/Khaki Skirt 1066; Green plaid skirt 1065; Skort 1070; Scooter 1286; Jumper 1352*

### SOCKS AND LEGGINGS

Socks, nylons, tights, and all leg coverings worn under skirts/shorts must be solid black, navy blue, or forest green. Socks must be matching, unaltered, and visible at all times. No designs (stripes or logos, etc.) allowed. Sweatpants may not be worn.

### SHOES

No sandals, open-heel/toe shoes, or boots allowed. No shoes with wheels allowed. No slip-on shoes may be worn during PE. Shoelaces must be tied.

### FREE DRESS GUIDELINES

No sweat, track, pajama pants, yoga pants, or ripped jeans allowed on free dress days. No midriff shirts or spaghetti straps allowed. Leggings are only to be worn as a supplementary garment to a skirt, dress or other pants.
