Communion at Curtis Lake is open to everyone and is not limited to members only. We understand this worship element as being a kind of memorial—a reminder—of the sacrifice Jesus made in giving His life for us. During His earthly ministry, Jesus called Himself the "Bread of Life." To those who heard it, they understood the significance of bread as life-giving, being that many of the calories consumed by the ancients came from a daily provision of bread. Bread was life, and now Jesus had become THE Bread of Life. That Jesus broke the bread before giving it to His disciples signified how His body would soon be broken as it was given in our place. He also took a cup of wine from the feast, full of its own symbolism, and He gave it new meaning. From now on, the cup of wine would represent a new covenant that God was making with all of humanity, whereby our sins would be forgiven and our lives made new because such

gifts were purchased with the blood of Jesus, which He shed on the cross.
