You will find a communication card in your program. Please fill in as much information as you're comfortable providing and drop it in the bucket near the exits when you leave.





**Communion** at Curtis Lake is open to everyone and is not limited to members only. We understand this worship element as being a kind of memorial—a reminder—of the sacrifice Jesus made in giving His life for us. During His earthly ministry, Jesus called Himself the "Bread of Life." To those who heard it, they understood the significance of bread as lifegiving, being that many of the calories consumed by the ancients came from a daily provision of bread. Bread was life, and now Jesus had become THE Bread of Life. That Jesus broke the bread before giving it to His disciples signified how His body would soon be broken as it was given in our place. He also took a cup of wine from the feast, full of its own symbolism, and He gave it new meaning. From now on, the cup of wine would represent a new covenant that God was making with all of humanity, whereby our sins

would be forgiven and our lives made new because such gifts were purchased with the blood of Jesus, which He shed on the cross.

We invite you to eat and drink together with us if you'd like to. To all, especially to those following Jesus, may we be reminded not to treat the Lord's Supper with disregard. Take time this morning to reflect and pray, "Search me, O God, and know my heart. See if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way."
