You will find a communication card in your program. Please fill in as much information as you're comfortable providing and drop it in the bucket near the exits when you leave.

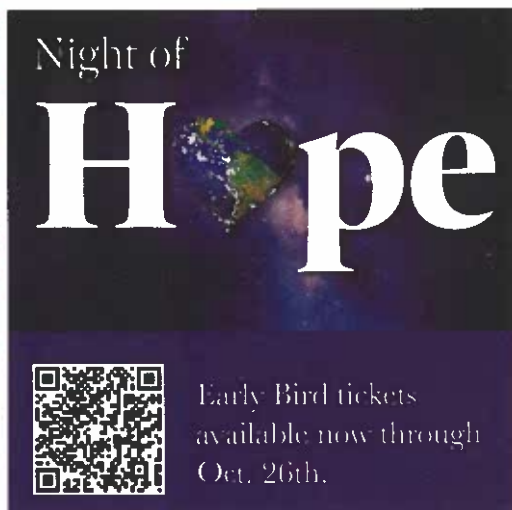
