

NORTH RIDGE CHURCH
ANNUAL FAMILY BUSINESS MEETING
FEBRUARY 23, 2020

Pastor Beth Zarnke called the meeting to order with a welcome and a prayer at 4:00 PM. She also highlighted upcoming special meetings.

Pastor August Hoffman highlighted non-financial reports ..new guests ..Youth Group (REMYX) activities ..new church app coming ..and informed the attendees that they could read more highlights online at nr.church/annualreport.

Pastor Aaron Herman called forward Mike and Tammy Kmiec and they shared their love of Northridge Church and their growth experience here in the past 9 months.

Pastor Tippen highlighted the 2019 Financial Reports citing very positive financial stability. He also encouraged anyone desiring to find out further information regarding the church finances to go to the [Vision and future](#) outline online.

Pastor Tippen introduced the Northridge Church Elders.

Elder Ben Lindner reported that there was 177 attendees present including children. Furthermore, 85 members were present at the meeting out of an official membership count of 232 or 37%. This constituted the required meeting quorum of 20% or more than 46 members. Motion by Donna Rozar, second by Keith Melvin to declare that a quorum was in attendance and to proceed with the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Elder Lindner continued and spoke in behalf of the Elder Board to expressed praise for the dedication, passion, and unity our staff exhibits as the leadership of the church. He then called the whole staff forward and introduced them.

Pastor Preston presented the Vision and the future of Northridge Church moving forward:

- ✠ NRC's focus for 2020 will be devotion to teaching (REACHing Higher), prayer and worship (REACHing Deeper), and fellowship and community (REACHing Wider) as outlined in:
Acts 2:42 ~ "They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles teaching, fellowship, the breaking of bread, and prayer."
- ✠ Pastor Preston shared the progress and status of Phase I of our expansion project.
- ✠ Pastor explained that we have tentatively selected the JC Penny space in the Mall to hold services while we are displaced by the expansion project.
- ✠ Pastor reviewed the goals and plans for the short-term use of the south-side property.

Pastor Preston closed the meeting with prayer and declared the meeting adjourned at 5:00 PM.
