# Shepherd's Corner

Meditate on the Lord's Passion



Dear St. Hedwig family:

One of the things we are called to do during Lent is to mediate on the Lord's Passion. We often do this by praying the Stations of the Cross, which we do as a community at 7:30 p.m. every Friday during Lent. When we meditate on the Lord's Passion, we come to know the consequences of our sins and how much our Lord had to suffer to reconcile us to the Father. We also come to know our Lord's love for us and how much he was willing to suffer so that we may have eternal life. It makes us more grateful for God's love and desire to love him in return.

Meditating on the Lord's Passion helps us to avoid sinning and to accept the suffering that comes our way. It helps us to deny ourselves in imitation of our Lord in reparation for our sins and for the salvation of the world. We accept daily annoyances and trials by uniting ourselves to Jesus and offering them to God out of love. The more we meditate on the Passion of Jesus, the more we will be conformed to him as we grow in humility and love of God and neighbor.

Besides the Stations of the Cross, there are many other ways to meditate on the Lord's Passion. When we pray the Sorrowful Mystery of the Rosary, we meditation on the suffering and death of Jesus. In the Divine Mercy Chaplet, we mediate on the Passion of Jesus as we plead for God's mercy to be poured out on us and the whole world. We can meditate on the Scriptural accounts on our Lord's Passion, and we can look and mediate on a crucifix. The saints would often hold the crucifix and kiss it as they reflect on the suffering of Jesus. I encourage everyone to have a personal crucifix in their room and to hold and kiss it often. One of the most powerful ways to enter into the suffering and death of Jesus is to watch the movie, *The Passion of the Christ*, directed by Mel Gibson. I have been doing this every year during Lent since before I entered the seminary, and every time I come away with a new insight. I recommend watching the movie by yourself in a prayerful way and with a box of Kleenex.

The saints encourage us to meditate on the Lord's passion routinely as part of our prayer life. This is one of the most efficacious ways to grow closer to our Lord and to grow in virtue. We should meditate on the Lord's Passion even outside of Lent by any of the means mentioned above. We can also meditate on the five wounds of Christ that were pierced for our salvation – his hands, feet, and side. Through meditation on the suffering of our Lord, we become more detached from the things of this world and long for the things of heaven. By meditating often on the suffering and death of our Lord, we will always keep in mind God's love for us and the evil of sins, and will want to do our part to make up for our sins and the sins of others. May we never take the suffering of Jesus for granted but always be grateful for his love and love him in return with all our heart, mind and soul.






