WHAT IS A LIFEGROUP?

Lifegroups are small groups that meet in someone's home or various places for a time of fellowship, spiritual growth, and prayer.

WHO CAN ATTEND A LIFEGROUP?

EVERYONE is welcome to attend a Lifegroup.

HOW IS A LIFEGROUP DIFFERENT FROM A BIBLE STUDY?

Both Lifegroups and Bible studies encourage spiritual growth and connection for individuals; however, Bible studies are in-depth studies which require extra time and often a cost for purchasing material such as a book or workbook. Lifegroups, on the other hand, mainly use DVD based curriculum and there is no added cost or extra time required for the study.

IS CHILDCARE PROVIDED FOR THE GROUPS?

Childcare is not provided. Each group decides what it will do regarding childcare.

HOW OFTEN DO LIFEGROUPS MEET?

Each Lifegroup varies; some meet bi-weekly and others meet weekly.

WHAT DO GROUPS STUDY?

Groups mainly study DVD curriculum; however some groups do Bible studies. Topics vary from group to group.
