Boy Scout Sunday

"Invite, Inspire, Ignite"

From the Pastor: (revised)

Today is Boy Scout Sunday. I want to welcome the families and friends of both young men who will be awarded the rank of Eagle Scout today. It is no small accomplishment to attain this rank.

Some people may wonder, "What is a boy scout?" They may have the picture of a group of boys around a campfire, or on a hike, or helping an elderly woman across the street with a bag of groceries. Some people may simply say, "I have no idea what a boy scout is, except that they are boys."

Lt. General Robert Baden-Powell of England founded Boy Scouts in England in 1907. Three years later on February 8, 1910, Boy Scouts of America was incorporated. That is exactly 108 years ago today. Across these 108 years countless numbers of boys have experienced scouting. I was a Cub Scout and a Boy Scout, though I never achieved the rank of Eagle. My father-in-law was an Eagle Scout, two of my brother-in-laws are Eagle Scouts, and I have a nephew who just received his Eagle. I think of what a Boy Scout looks like and I think of them.

Baden-Powell developed something called the Boy Scout Law. It answers the question, "What is a Scout?" like this, ***A Scout Is: Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent.***

Today, as two young men step forward to receive the rank of Eagle Scout, we see once more what a Boy Scout looks like. Throughout their lives they will live by the example of what the Scout Law instructs. Congratulations!
