From the Pastor

Today is Pentecost. Fifty days ago we were celebrating Easter and Christ's victory over sin and death. Today, as we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the church, I am reminded of this prayer: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth." Today is Pentecost - truly a day of celebration for the entire church.

So then, how shall we celebrate? During the 9:00 worship hour, we will receive two adults into Full Membership and confirm and receive eight young people into Full Membership. During the 11:00 worship hour, two children will be baptized. This is how we will celebrate as we give thanks to God for these signs of what is being given through the power of the Holy Spirit.

At Confirmation a person declares publicly their faith in Jesus Christ. Because each of the eight confirmands have already been baptized, we will join each of them in renewing our baptismal vows.

These vows are made up of three promises we make, which are:

A renunciation of the spiritual forces of wickedness, a rejection of the evil powers of this world, and personal repentance of their sin.

An acceptance of the freedom and power God gives to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves, and

Acceptance of Jesus Christ as their Lord, putting their whole trust in his grace, and promising to serve him in union with the church.
