WORSHIP MINISTRY

The Worship Ministry at NCC seeks to glorify God by inviting people into an unhindered worship experience with the gathered body of Christ.

Music Team

Vocalists include students in tenth grade through adults with choral experience who have auditioned with our Music Director Greg Macaluso, and met with our Senior Pastor Mark Bolton. The serving commitment for these serving teams runs from September through August each year.

Vocalists and instrumentalists lead the congregation in authentic worship of God through a wide variety of music, from hymns to contemporary worship music. Teams of various sizes are scheduled from a roster of team members who serve twice a month or more. Team Members are given material in the form of song sheets and audio files via the internet about a week in advance. Vocalist rehearsals are on Wednesday evenings. The entire team serves on Sunday mornings from 7:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.


