WORSHIP MINISTRY

The Worship Ministry at NCC seeks to glorify God by inviting people into an unhindered worship experience with the gathered body of Christ.

Music Team

Vocalists include students in tenth grade through adults with choral experience who have auditioned with our Worship Pastor, Matt Mason, and met with our Senior Pastor Mark Bolton. The serving commitment for these serving teams runs from September through August each year.

Singers and musicians lead the congregation in authentic worship of God through a wide variety of music, from hymns to contemporary worship music. Team members are given song sheets and audio files about a week in advance. Vocalist rehearsals are on Wednesday evenings. Teams of various sizes serve on Sundays from 7:30 a.m.–12:15 p.m.


