Cranberry Cinnamon Roll Wreath

Ingredients



2 cans (17.5 oz) refrigerated Pillsbury™ Grands™ Cinnamon Rolls with Cream Cheese Icing (5 count)
½ cup cranberry jam or whole berry cranberry sauce
Orange zest, for garnish

Directions

- 1) Heat oven to 350°F. Without separating the rolls, place one package of the cinnamon roll dough on a cutting board. Unroll the dough into a rectangle shape, spread ¼ cup of cranberry sauce evenly on top of the dough, and reroll the dough. Repeat with remaining dough and cranberry sauce.
- 2) Separate rolls. Place the rolls in a circle on a baking sheet sprayed with cooking spray, overlapping the rolls by about 1 inch.
- 3) Bake for 23 to 27 minutes until the centers are thoroughly baked and the edges are deep golden brown. Cool for 5 minutes.
- 4) In a microwave-safe bowl, warm the cream cheese icing in the microwave for 10 seconds. Drizzle the icing over the cinnamon roll wreath. Garnish with orange zest.

Yield: 10 servings

Recipe Tips: For a more festive centerpiece, garnish the cinnamon roll wreath with fresh cranberries, rosemary sprigs, and orange slices.

Not in the mood for cranberry? Substitute the cranberry sauce for your favorite jam—any berry, cherry, or rhubarb would be delicious.

Want to make the rolls ahead of time? Assemble the rolls on the baking sheet, cover them tightly, and refrigerate overnight. Let the wreath stand at room temperature for 15 minutes, then bake.

Serve the remaining icing on the side for dipping!
