



## **A Mission Without Boundaries**

Since the one true God revealed in the Bible is a missionary God, His people should be missionary people. God's mission is clear: through the death and resurrection of His Only Son, Jesus, God will redeem a people for Himself from all nations, tribes, peoples, and languages. God's method is also clear: He will use the redeemed to carry the Good News of salvation to all peoples. This study in the book of Acts will help you understand what this means for you. However, since God is Lord over the entire planet, we should seek to be involved in the work He is doing everywhere, both overseas and locally. This study will help you discover your role, or roles, God has designed for you in His missionary plan. God is reaching the nations—and His plan involves us. The mission is full of opportunities; has a message; must be met with courage; soaked in prayer, leads us outside of our comfort zone, and is without boundaries.
