"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." – Psalm 46:1

This verse was a meaningful one for Martin Luther and the reformers. In a quickly changing world that seemed on soon to spin out of control Luther shaped the promises of the Psalm 46 into the powerful hymn, "A Mighty Fortress is Our God." God is a fortress in our lives as we keep busy in so many ways.

October is a month full of life for our congregation and community! It begins with my time away for continuing education, a gift I am grateful for as I grow and learn in ministry. During that time, Pastor Diane will be leading worship, including our annual **Blessing of the Pets** - a joyful reminder that God's creation is wide and good, and that our faithful companions also share in God's care.

October is also the month of our **Austin County Fair**, where we gather to celebrate tradition, hard work, and fellowship and a funnel cake or two! We give thanks for community life that reminds us of God's abundant provision and a place where we can reconnect with friends and neighbors.

The September Council Meeting took place Monday, September 8th, 2025 in the Adult Classroom. In attendance were Shannon Johnson, Lynn Martine, Christina Koehn, Kirk Hoppe, Jared Schubert, Tommy Kowles, Wendy Jackson, Amy Voelkel, Livia Marshall, and Fritz Nelius. The meeting was called to order by Fritz Nelius at 6:15pm.

Opening Devotion – Fritz Nelius led us in prayer.

Consensus Agenda – August Minutes, Financial & Committee Reports were reviewed & approved.

Discussion Agenda -

Old Business - The search continues to find new Council Members for the upcoming term. The upcoming Congregational Meeting will include voting for the Operational Budget for the New Year. Committee Budget Reports were due September 8th, 2025. A temporary roof repair has been made to the garden shed to address leaking. The Retreat Center roof has been evaluated and no current leaks have been discovered.

New Business - A request was presented to change the date of the scheduled Congregational Meeting to Sunday, October 19th, 2025, due to conflicts with the Oktoberfest Celebration, motion carried. Items presented for the Congregational Meeting include voting in new Council Members as well as voting to approve the Operational Budget for the new year. New Staff Members were announced -Ashlin Gordon will be coming on as the new Youth Engagement Leader & Rev. Diane Roth will be filling the role of Part- Time Assisting Pastor. The discussion on the Recovery Support Group was tabled pending more information. Discussion was had regarding funds donated for a flagpole at the columbarium site, motion was made to allow the Columbarium Committee to make decisions regarding the flagpole, motion carried. The Retreat Center requested funds for the removal of 5 dead trees primarily around Marshall's home site. They had a bid from Peschel Tree Services in the amount of \$3700.00, motion carried.

The next Council Meeting is October 13th, 2025 at 6:15pm in the Adult Classroom. The meeting concluded with the Lord's Prayer at 7:10pm.

Our goal is \$80,000.


We have already raised \$25,154.
